Athlete's Foot

- Tea Tree Oil 5.4%/ Lavendar Oil 1%/ Clotrimazole 1%/ Undecylenic Acid 5%/ Urea 5% Topical Cream

Blisters

- Blister Ointment HC 2%

Corns/Callouses

- Salicylic Acid 10%/Podophyllum 10%/Trichloroacetic Acid 10% (W/V) Topical Solution (**Corns and Callous Therapy**)
- Salicylic Acid/ Menthol Cream (**Corn and Callous Removal Cream**)

Heel Spurs

- Ketoprofen 10% Topical Lipoderm® (Pentylene Glycol)
- Amitriptylline HCl 2% / Baclofen 5% / Ketamine HCl 5% / Ketoprofen 10% Topical Lipoderm®
- Amitriptylline HCl 2% / Ketoprofen 2% / Carbamazepine 2% Topical Lipoderm
- Ibuprofen 20% in Lipoderm® Transdermal Gel

Plantar Fasciitis

- Ketoprofen 20% / Ibuprofen 2% / Ketamine 2% / Clonidine 0.2% / Amitriptylline HCl 2% / Guaifenesin 2% Baclofen 5% Topical Lipoderm®

- Amitriptylline HCl 2% / Ketoprofen 2% / Carbamazepine 2% Topical Lipoderm®

- Urea 40% Ointment
- Urea 40% / Bacitracin/Clotrimazole/Ibuprofen/DDG Ointment

Nail Fungus

- Itraconazole 1% / Ibuprofen 2% in DMSO Nail Polish
- Fluconazole 1% / DMSO Topical Solution

Fungal Skin Infections

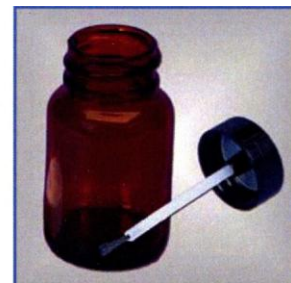
- Clotrimazole 2% / Ibuprofen 2% / Tea Tree Oil 1% Topical Cream

Methicillin-Resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA)

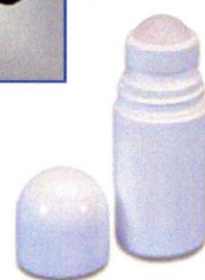
- Clindamycin 3% / Doxycycline 1% Topical Ointment
