Behavioral Issues

- Amitriptyline HCl 5mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm (Vet)
- Buspirone 1.25 mg/0.2 mL Topical Lipoderm (Vet)

Sedation / restraint / Pre-Anesthesia

- Acepromazine Maleate 5 mg/0.3 mL Topical Lipoderm (Vet)
- Butorphanol Tartrate 20 mg/mL Topical Lipoderm
- Naltrexone HCl 50 mg/mL Oil Oral Suspension (Vet-Feline)
- Amitriptyline 20 mg/mL Oil Oral Suspension (Vet-Feline)

Cat Transdermal Formulas

Many drugs are requested for transdermal feline use.

- Methimazole 5 mg/0.12 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Tramadol Hcl 10 mg/0.12 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Acepromazine Maleate 5 mg/0.3 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Amitriptyline Hcl 10 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Amlodipine 0.625 mg/0.2 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Atenolol 6.25 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Buspirone Hcl 1.25 mg/0.2 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Famotidine 2.5 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Ivermectin 0.1 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Methimazole 5mg/0.1 Gm Topical Lipoderm
- Cisapride 2.5 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Phenobarbital 10 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Glipizide 2.5 mg/0.1 mL Topical Lipoderm
- Enrofloxacin 25 mg/0.2 mL Topical Lipoderm (Vet)

Chronic Renal Failure / Hypoparathyroidism

- Calcitriol 20 nanogram/0.2 mL Oil Oral Solution (Vet)
- Calcitriol 4 nanograms/0.25 mL Fixed Oil Oral Solution (Vet)

Gastrointestinal

- Famotidine 2.5 mg/0.1 mL Oral Suspension
- Hairball Remedy (Vet—Feline)
- Cisapride 2.5 mg/0.1 mL Oral Suspension
- Omeprazole 3 mg/ml Oral Suspension
- Metoclopramide 2 mg/0.1 mL Topical PLO (Vet)
- Cyclosporin (A) 1% Oil Solution
